

MASS INTENTIONS AT ST. COLUMBA'S & ST. THERESA'S

An Explanatory Note:

The Christian faithful who give an offering to apply Mass for their intention contribute to the good of the Church and by that offering share in its concern to support its ministers and works.

Code of Canon Law, Canon 946

To arrange for a Mass to be celebrated for a particular intention you will need to provide Fr. Jonathan with:

- Your own name, and a contact number.
- The intention e.g. (deceased) person's name, occasion/ event/ thanksgiving/ anniversary etc.
- The number of Masses requested.
- The date(s) and time(s) for the Mass(es) to be celebrated, if you have a specific requirement.
- The suggested Mass offering is £10, but no-one should feel that they cannot have Mass celebrated for their intention because of their financial circumstances. All Mass offerings are paid into the parish account to support the work of the Parish.

Fr. Jonathan can provide a special envelope for this, or you may use your own, to be handed in preferably at the Priest's Sacristy, but at the Presbytery if necessary.

All requests are entered in the parish Intentions Register and Fr. Jonathan endeavours to celebrate the Masses on the date and at the time requested, or as nearly as possible. Where there is no date/time specified, requests are met in order of date of receipt. One Mass each Sunday is celebrated for the intention of the parish generally. During the month of November Masses are celebrated for Holy Souls and your written intentions are placed before the Altar; special envelopes are provided for this also.

You should consult the Mass Intentions listed in the parish Newsletter to check when your request is to be fulfilled.
